A regular tax season in Summary

five major deadlines to look out for

- January 16, 2024 4th Quarter 2023 estimated tax payment due.
- January 31, 2024 Due date for employers to send W-2 forms and certain 1099 forms are sent.
- February 15, 2024 Reclaim your exemption from withholding.
- March 15, 2024 Partnerships and S-Corporations due to file or extend.
- April 15, 2024 Individual tax day (unless extended due to local state holiday), Deadline to File Form 4868 to request an extension and pay expected tax due, First quarter 2024 estimated tax payment due.
